Emoji day

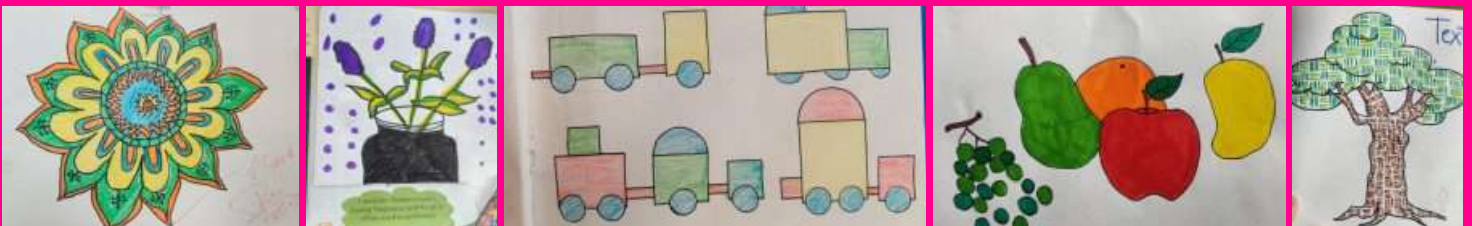

“Show your smile today and stay positive“.

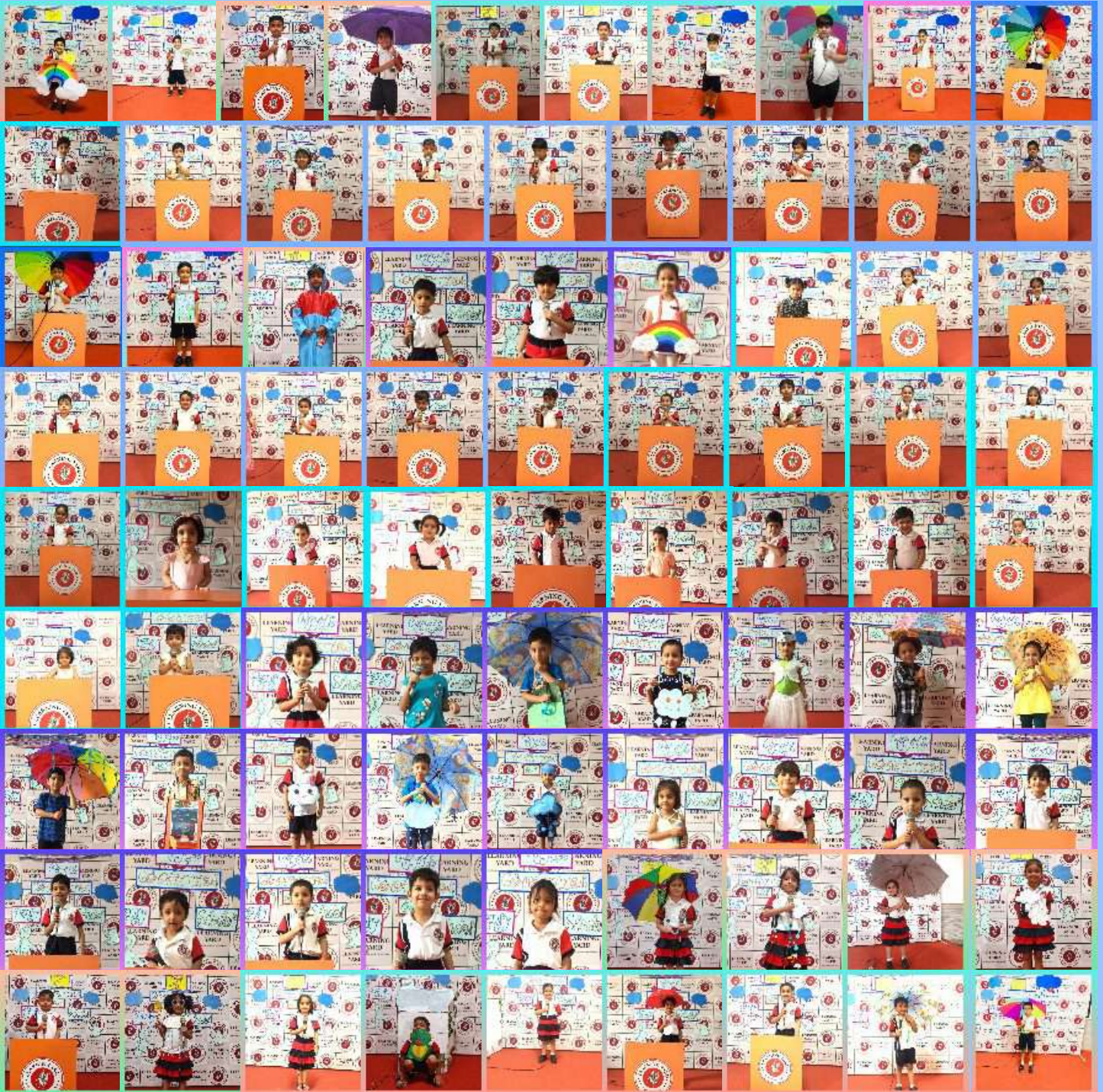

11 August 2022

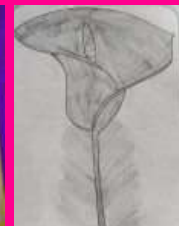
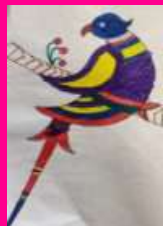


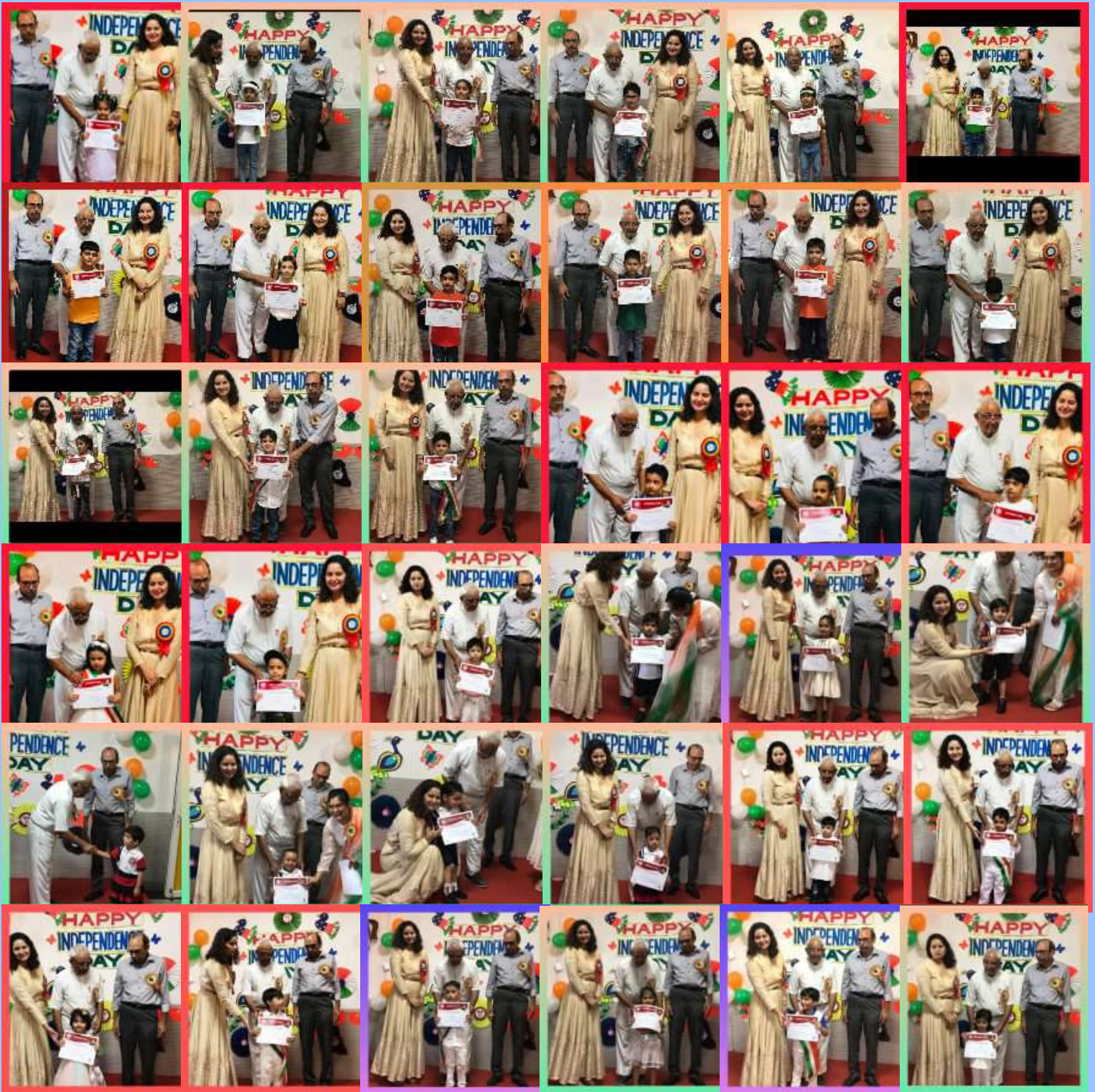

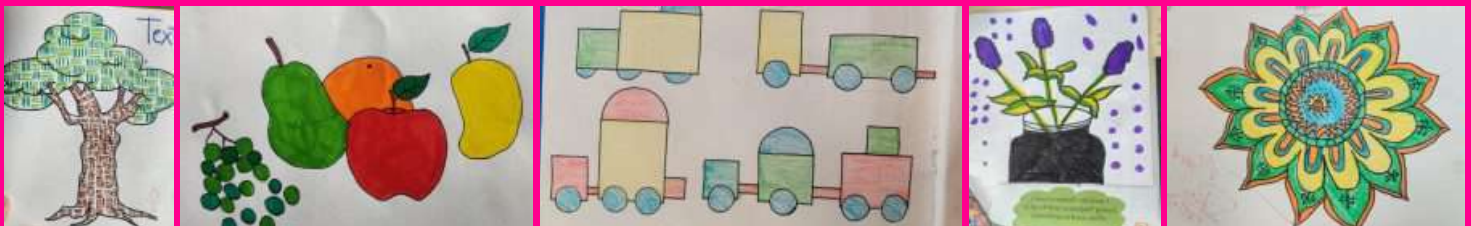
Independence Day Celebration
